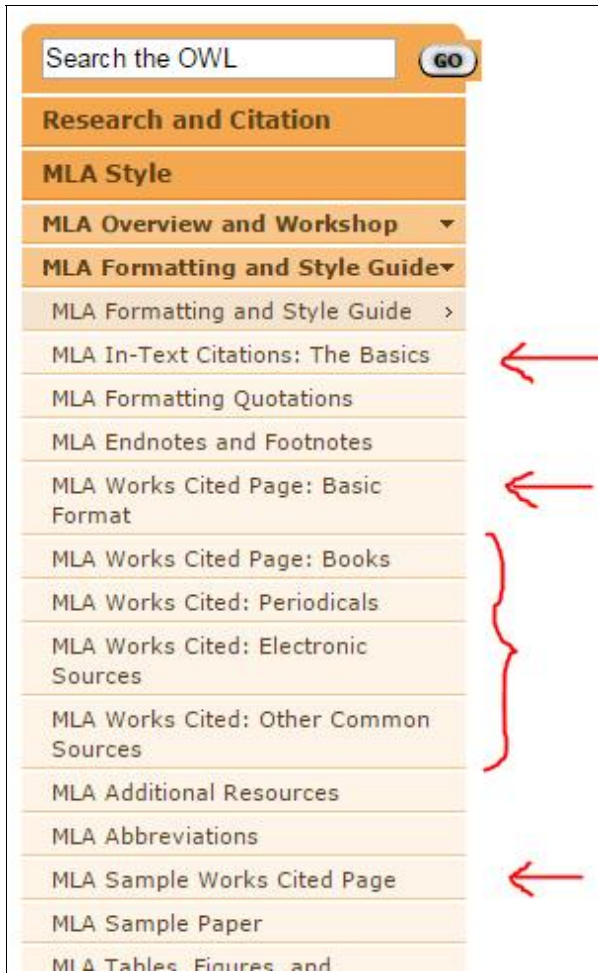


Bibliography Workshop – Our Works Cited Page

For a mistake-free bibliography, follow the steps below:

First, get out your bibliography. You should have cited 8-10 sources.

Second, go to the Purdue Online Writing Lab's MLA formatting and Style

Third, note the menu (see picture to the left). I've drawn arrows to point out where you'll need to go.

Fourth, go to the MLA Works Cited Page: Basic Format

Fifth: Using your own bibliography, find how to cite each source and double check your citations.

Sixth: Use the heading "Works Cited" as the title (not in quotes). Make sure to center it.

Lastly, Trade with a friend. Go over their Bibliography and make sure it's done correctly. **IMPORTANT:** Make sure you do this step – it is actually easier to catch mistakes on someone else's than on your own work. Do this!
