Title of Bill:

The Act to Reduce the Harmful Effects of Cashews

BE IT ENACTED BY THE ANIMAS HIGH SCHOOL MODEL SENATE

- 1 Preamble: Whereas cashews are known for their malicious intent and lethal nature, they
2 have infiltrated the United States with their innocent facade and polluted our supply of nuts,
3 and these imposter peanuts pose a threat to the health of our citizen through the alarmingly
4 high fat content and curved shape that causes a high choking hazard, as well as the threat
5 they pose as a fire hazard due to their high oil content and combustibility, and because of
6 their particularly bland nature they give a bad name to all nut species which is particularly
7 alarming given the recent study, “**Cash-ew!**” showing significant health benefits associated
8 with the consumptions of most nuts,

- 10 SECTION 1: Let it be unlawful for an individual to possess cashews or any product derived
11 thereof.
- 12 Sub-SECTION A: The possession of any amount of cashews shall be punished by a
13 fine of 12,000\$ or up to 6 years in prison.

- 15 SECTION 2: Let it be unlawful for a business to grow or distribute cashews in any capacity.
16 Sub-SECTION A: The growth or distribution of cashews will be punished by a fine of
17 50,000\$ or 10 years in prison.

- 19 SECTION 3: Let it be unlawful to import or export cashews.
20 Sub-SECTION A: The importation or exportation of cashews will be punished by
21 death.

- 23 SECTION 4: Exceptions will only be allowed when cashews are used in the production of
24 bio-fuels by strictly regulated corporations or businesses.
- 25 Sub-SECTION A: A committee of government sanctioned nut experts shall be
26 instated to monitor the production of cashew based bio-fuels to ensure all cashew
27 based products are used only for the production of energy.
- 28 Sub-SECTION B: Said committee shall also ensure the correct disposal of any cashew
29 waste.
- 30 Sub-SECTION C: Non complying groups shall be punished in a manner in keeping
31 with sections 1-3 above.

- 34 SECTION 5: This bill shall go into effect 364 days after passed.
