Weighty, dense, slow	Spondee (TUM TUM)
Dramatic	Spondee (TUM TUM)
Weak, invisible, unsteady	Pyrrhic (te te)
Forceful, abrupt	Anacrusis (TUM) at the start of a line, often combined with an extra- syllable ending to make a "dovetail foot."
Musical quality	Carry the foot across two words
Choppy, staccato	Keep the foot within the words

Dance-like sensual quality that goes with rhyme	Trimeter
Song-like or comic quality	Tetrameter - divides line into two equal halves with a pause in the middle. This pattern is hard to break out of.
Comfortable	Pentameter
Full, stuffed, above and beyond, stretching	Hexameter
