Tuesday April 21st	<p>Goal: Critique and refine Part II and prepare Parts III and IV for review</p> <p>This week is all about feedback. We will balance graded peer critique with giving you additional work time to finish sections of your paper. This is THE WEEK to make it happen. Complete drafts are due Friday!!!</p> <p>We'll start by talking about your SPAM-3 advisor meeting. You'll choose your own deadline to send this email out. Obviously the sooner you complete your draft and meet with your advisor, the better for you. You need to give them at least four days before the meeting to read your paper.</p> <p>This day for critique we'll focus on Part II. You will assess your own paper and two others (I will assign crit groups). Each critique this week will be worth TEN pass/fail points. If you miss, you'll have to make these up. Critique should take 30-40 minutes. You should have three printed copies.</p> <p>We will also do some exercises on commas using a handout that I've prepared. Don't give me no comma splices on your final paper. It will cost you!!</p>	Bring in two printed copies of Parts III & IV, either your written pages or outline
Wednesday, April 22nd Earth Day!	<p>Goal: Critique and refine parts III & IV</p> <p>Most of this day you'll be working closely with a partner reading and critiquing their Parts III & IV. This will help you know how to evaluate your own work.</p>	Bring in two printed copies of Parts IV & V, either your written pages or outline.
Thursday, April 23rd	<p>Goal: Critique and refine parts IV & V</p> <p>Most of this day you'll be working with a different partner to refine Parts IV and V. If you don't have a final copy of your paper, you should spend the rest of the class finishing this up. After this class, you should be ready to proof and finalize your essay.</p>	Finish your essay. Don't forget to adhere to the formatting and include a Works Cited Page
