- You must create a materials list of everything you need to complete this project, and state whether or not you have access to these items.

- You must complete a storyboard, or “loose script” concept for your video, and show it to me before I loosen my reigns on your classroom requirements. This can be done on a blank sheet of paper, and can take many forms. You can write a script, a storyboard showing all of the scenes, or you may write me a film abstract (consisting of the overarching concept and a summary of what you expect the outcome to be), plot arc, or ven diagram.

If you will be leaving campus, I *need* to know where you are going and what you will be doing so that I can report this to my superiors if needed. As a part of your daily schedule, you must have an achievable but ambitious benchmark (goal). It is through this that we will measure progress toward a finished video.

- Once you have a clear idea of what you want to do, you must send me a list of tasks that the group must accomplish and what person or people are responsible for getting it done.
