

Humanities 12: Constitution Test Corrections

If you feel that your grade on this test does not represent your learning, you have the option of correcting your answer to receive additional credit. Here are the ground rules:

You have one week from the return date of the test to submit test corrections

You can receive a maximum of 3/4 of the points for any given question:

- Full correction of a one point question will get 3/4 of a point
- Full correction of a ten point question will get you 7.5 points.
- Full correction of the twenty-point question will get you 15 points

You must pass back your test to me with a print out of your corrections.

Corrections should take the following form:

- Cut and paste or re-type the question from the original exam
- Write several sentences or a short paragraph indicating why you originally missed the question, and what the correct answer is and why
